

Heyfield - Licola - Heyfield Social Bike Ride

- Dates Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 November, 2012
- Ride Start 10.30am from Heyfield (or 7.00 AM from Bikeland Warragul. Warragul to Heyfield is 96kms, the 54 kms frm Heyfield to Licola...the first 96 km will be ridden at a 30kmh average)
- Ride Distance 54 kms each way (Heyfield to Licola....this ride will be ridden at the pace of your choice.....you have all day to make it!)
- Sag Wagons and trailers (two 6@4 trailers will be used for luggage as well as any cars travelling up. Pack to a minimum but make sure you bring snacks, pillow, fresh change of clothes, a sleeping bag, towel etc)

Costs:-

- 1. Bunk Bed Accommodation per person (byo sleeping bag or linen and pillow) including dinner (see schedule)
- 2. No Camping is available at the Licola Wilderness Village this year. (you have to arrange your own accommodation at the Caravan Park if you wish to camp)
- 3. Meals Saturday night's dinner is provided by Wheelie Good Pizzas of Trafalgar. It includes entrée garlic and marguerite pizzas followed by one small pizza each. Additional pizzas can be purchased for \$10 each. Lunch for Saturday and Sunday, breakfast on Sunday, and other snacks to be supplied by yourself. We note there is a milk bar available for sugar hits, sausage rolls and ice creams! We note that a communal kitchen and BBQ is available for cooking up additional snacks and preparing lunches etc. Pack a bottle of red or your favourite beer!
